### **SUPERINTENDENT'S DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

The Board shall offer the Superintendent encouragement and assistance for his own professional development. So that he or she may keep the Board and professional staff informed of new and promising educational developments, the Board will encourage the Superintendent to attend educational conferences, seminars, workshops, and other professional meetings; visit other school systems; and use other means to keep abreast of modern educational thought and practices. The Superintendent shall notify the Board President of any professional meetings which will cause him or her to be absent from the district for more than three days.

### **SUPERINTENDENT'S DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES**

#### **(Continuing Professional Development of Administrators)**

In a society shaken by rapid and fundamental change, education remains the most important public enterprise. Effective leadership of that enterprise demands that educational executives maintain a thorough understanding of the art and science of management, learning theory, and curriculum development, and the social, political, and economic forces which affect the purposes and process of education.

We urge educational executives to renew their commitment to continuing professional and personal growth, and to set aside time each year to attend seminars and conventions. We call on school boards to provide administrators the time, support, and incentives necessary for them to pursue professional excellence. Finally, we commend and encourage the efforts of universities, administrators' associations, and the AASA National Academy for School Executives to provide programs designed to meet the professional growth needs of administrators.

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
