DISTRIBUTION OF PRINTED OR WRITTEN MATERIAL,

ANNOUNCEMENTS, OR ADVERTISEMENTS

A. Students have the right to distribute written material or announcements on school premises providing certain standards pertaining to content and distribution regulations are met. School level procedures should not be designed to prohibit or inhibit the distribution of material which meets acceptable standards, will not disrupt normal school activities, and is to be distributed in an orderly, peaceful manner so as not to coerce any other person into accepting or rejecting the material. Standards and procedures include:

1. No printed written material, announcement or advertisement may be distributed on school premises if:

- a. The material is harmful to students
- b. The contents or distribution interferes with the orderly operation of discipline of the school.
- c. It promotes violence or disorder.
- d. It constitutes an invasion of the privacy of others.

e. It is in violation of the various libel or obscenity laws.

2. Material for distribution and the plan of distribution must be submitted to the school principal five days prior to the planned date of distribution. If the material is considered questionable, or the plan of distribution is not acceptable, and the request is denied, an appeal may be made to the Superintendent for reconsideration.
