#### Fine Arts



Nebo elementary school students are making academic "GAINS" with the help of a staff development program that utilizes arts integration. "Growing Arts in Nebo Schools" (GAINS) is a program designed to provide classroom teachers with grade-

specific tools that help them *integrate instruction* in *art, dance, drama*, and *music* into their daily instruction of language arts, mathematics, science, and other curricula.

# The Advanced Learning Center (ALC)



The ALC provides early college and career courses to high school students while students stay involved at their primary school. The ALC offers a wide variety of courses for college credit, career readiness, and industry certification.

Courses include computer programming and repair, retail management, digital media and video production, medical science, building construction, and engineering/drafting. #### Career and Technical Education (CTE)




and develop a *College and Career Readiness Plan* for *success*. For more information, students should visit with their current high school counselor and go to:www.utahcte.org.

## College and Career Ready

Every Nebo student can be a *college*- and *career-ready student* prepared to *succeed* in *college* and in *workforce training*. Students can earn *college credit* through *Advanced Placement (AP)* and *Concurrent Enrollment* classes.

### Technology



- Our district continues to *emphasize technology integration* including LCD projectors, audio enhancement systems, document cameras, hand-held devices, and mobile labs in classrooms to engage teachers and students in *21*<sup>st</sup> *Century* teaching and learning.
- Currently, there are 150 wired computer labs that include 5,800 computers, 10 wireless mobile laptop/Netbook labs that include 360 devices, 30 iPad labs with sync carts that include 1,000 devices, and 200 wireless Chromebook labs that include

over 11,000 devices in 41 schools and 5 programs. Students use hundreds of personal technology devices daily.
