### Nebo District Areas of Focus

- Students have access to college courses and an ability to earn an associate's degree upon graduation.
- Nebo School District saved parents and students over \$8.5 million in the 2018-19 school year by providing Concurrent Enrollment (CE) and



- Enrollment (CE) and Advanced Placement (AP) classes for *college credit*.
- Eighty-nine percent of Nebo student graduates took at least one Concurrent Enrollment, Advanced Placement, or MTECH class during their high school experience to help them become college and career ready.
- Advanced Placement (AP) students, in 20 different classes, earned 4,528 college credits.

- Nebo students, in approximately 86 different classes, earned 26,924 college credits by successfully completing Concurrent Enrollment classes.
- Nebo District's Career and Technology Education students passed 8,296 Skill Certification tests and industry credentials.
- Nebo students' ACT scores exceeded the national and state scores in every category–English, Mathematics, Reading, Science, and Composite.
- Nebo students' test scores continue to increase in mathematics, science, and writing.
- Nebo School District has a graduation rate of 90 percent, which is higher than the state average of 87 percent.
- Nebo Education Foundation received approximately \$275,000 in donations to fund projects in schools.
- More than \$19 million was awarded in scholarships to our graduates this past year.
- Nebo District belongs to the Utah Valley University/MTECH K-16 Alliance and is a member of the Brigham Young University Public School Partnership.

- is the **sixth largest** district in Utah.
- operates 30 elementary schools, 13 secondary schools, and 5 special program schools.
- has 131 buses travel approximately 8,736 miles per day or 1.5 million miles each year.

- is the fifth largest employer in Utah County with approximately 4,500 full- and part-time employees.

Every Nebo student can be prepared to **succeed** in college and in workforce training. Students can earn **college credit** through Advanced Placement (AP) and Concurrent Enrollment (CE) classes.

Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs help students explore a variety of careers in business, agriculture, marketing, information technology, health science, technology and engineering, family and consumer science, and skilled and technical

## Technology

Our district continues to emphasize technology integration. Currently, Nebo has 37,000 devices that include computers, wireless Chromebooks, and iPads. There are 155 wired computer labs that include 6,000 computers, 35 iPad labs with sync carts that include 1,200 devices, and 450 wireless Chromebook labs in 42 schools and 5 programs. Students use hundreds of personal technology devices daily.



## Nebo District is Committed to Maintaining Safe Schools

- A Crisis Intervention Team and emergency response plans are in place at every school.
- Nebo District has strict safe and drug-free school policies.
- Campus supervisors, security cameras, and school resource officers provide additional safety for students and buildings.
- Nebo District filters Internet and email use for student safety.
- The SafeUT Crisis Chat and Tip Line is a statewide service that provides real-time crisis intervention to youth through live chat and a confidential tip program right from the smartphone. All junior high and high school students received training on the app and have been encouraged to put the SafeUT app on their phone. In addition, all schools in Nebo School District have a link to the SafeUT tip line on their school websites.
