This is a welding class where you will be taught the basics of SMAW (Stick) welding, GMAW (MIG) welding, GTAW (TIG) welding, plasma cutting, and oxyfuel cutting. Items you will be required to bring to each session include leather welding gloves, safety glasses, pliers, coveralls, or welding jackets. Each session will include basic information and demonstration of the process and then include individual process practice. Materials will be provided for the practice of each process. After the initial classes, time will be allotted for you to work on an individual project of your design and choosing. Project materials for the class will not be provided.
