School Bus Rules

- 1. Students shall obey promptly and respectfully the directions of the bus driver or supervisor.
- 2. Students shall keep head and arms inside the bus and remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- 3. Do not throw any object in or out of the bus.
- 4. Keep your hands and feet to yourself. Do not shove, push or fight.
- 5. Do not eat or drink without the driver's permission.
- 6. Students shall not be loud, obscene, vulgar or profane in words or actions.
- 7. Students shall not tamper with the bus or any of its equipment.
- 8. Do not litter or clutter the aisles.
- 9. Students damaging the bus in any way will be required to pay for the damage.
- 10. Students will not exit the bus except at their regular stop without written permission from parent/guardian.

Major offenses are any actions which endanger safety to bus and/or riders, the use or possession of tobacco, drugs, alcohol, etc., any vandalism to the bus, firearms or any other dangerous objects and any other Safe School Violation (refer to Board Policy JDA).

Any violation of the above rules can lead to disciplinary action.
